Georgia AHEC Scholars is a two-year nationally recognized multidisciplinary certificate program, designed to better prepare health profession students for future practice in rural and urban underserved communities. In addition, the program provides a unique opportunity for the participants to gain hands-on training and experience.



Eligibility

- Enrolled in a Georgia health professions degree program and be two years from program completion
- Requires a two year commitment and minimum overall GPA of 2.5



Benefits

- Participate in professional conferences and trainings
- Enhance resume
- Expand professional network
- Receive a stipend upon completion of each program year



Commitment

- Year 1: 40 hours of didactic/coursework
- Year 2: 40 hours of didactic/coursework and 40 hours of community-based training activities
- Post program follow-up

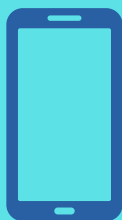
